Arrival by plane

The closest international airport is Stockholm Arlanda airport, situated about 40 km from downtown Stockholm, which is a 35 minutes drive. When arriving at Arlanda airport you can continue to central Stockholm by the Arlanda Express train (Snabbtåg) or by the airport coaches (Flygbussarna). The Arlanda Express (20 minutes; max. 2 stops) is faster and has fewer stops, but costs more than the airport coaches (ca. 35 minutes). When arriving at the central train station, please continue as explained below.

By subway/underground (T for Tunnelbana)

Take the red line heading towards Mörby Centrum. Exit at Tekniska Högskolan and follow the signs to Körbärsvägen, where the hotel is located.

The hotel is not far from the Royal Institute of Technology (Kungliga Tekniska Högskolan), so you can walk to our conference site at Teknikringen 78B, room 156.
